

RMPB Grant Recipients for Fiscal Year July 1, 2011 – June 30, 2012

Barbour County Commission, \$5,000 to provide for the creation of preservation microfilm of the County Clerk's Deed Books.

Berkeley County Commission, \$3,000 to provide for the purchase of public computers to access the Circuit Clerk's records.

Boone County Commission, \$10,000 to provide for the purchase of manually operated moveable track shelving to enhance access to the Circuit Clerk's case files.

Cabell County Commission, \$5,000 to provide for preservation microfilming and digital conversion of the County Clerk's Deed Books.

Clay County Commission, \$9,691 to provide for preservation microfilming and digital conversion of the Circuit Clerk's Criminal, Civil, and Domestic Violence Orders Books.

Fayette County Commission, \$9,918 to provide for preservation microfilming and digital conversion of the Circuit Clerk's Civil and Criminal Index Books.
