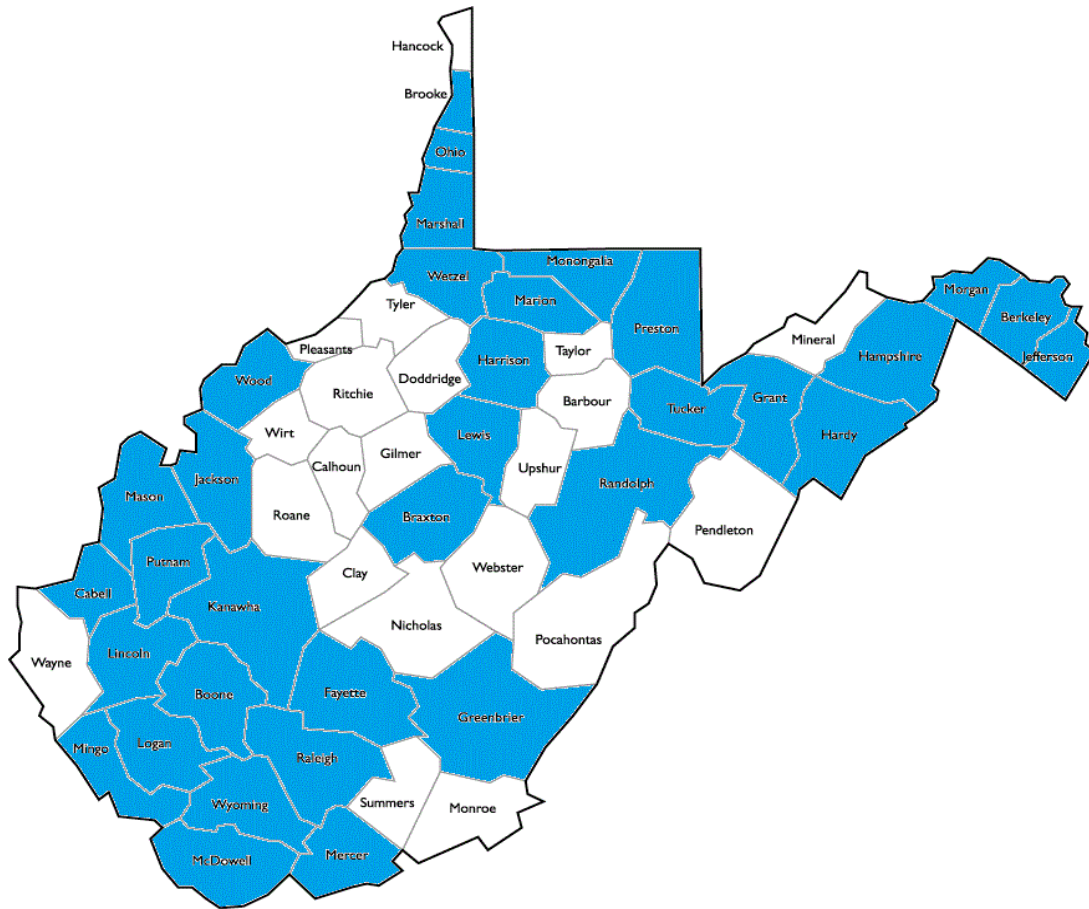

Introduction

West Virginia Division of Culture and History (WVDCH)

The mission of the West Virginia Division of Culture and History is to identify, preserve, protect, promote, and present the ideas, arts, and artifacts of West Virginia's heritage, building pride in our past accomplishments and confidence in our future.

West Virginia Commission on the Arts (WVCA)

The mission of the West Virginia Commission on the Arts is to foster a fertile environment for the artistic, cultural, educational and economic development of the state.

Cultural Facilities and Capital Resources Grant program-Goals and Priorities:

- Public access to arts and history
- Collaborations and partnerships to invest in cultural experiences
- Service to multi-county regions
- Economic development
- Cultural development in rural, under-served or minority communities
- Health and safety improvements
- Access to facilities for artists and others with disabilities
- Improve, expand or rehabilitate existing buildings to provide for physical accessibility
- Reduce an organization's operating costs

This report is a summary of activity of the last fifteen years (FY01-FY15) of the Cultural Facilities and Capital Resources Grant program (CFCRG) through the WVDCH Arts Section and WVCA. Since FY2001, this competitive grant program has granted a total of \$17,761,106.08 and has served 34 counties in the state. Each grant requires significant planning, development of local expertise, inclusion of specialists in architecture, non-profit management, fund raising and arts program development. This report highlights a strong interest in the arts and history in WV and provides an overview of the variety of projects, the distribution of funds and the communities and counties impacted by this program.

The CFCRG program was created by a collaboration of WV Arts Advocacy, the WVDCH/WVCA and Senator Oshel B. Craigo, the former WV Senate Finance Chairman. The Senator authored S.B. 657 (2000), which dedicates one-half of one percent (.005%) of net proceeds from the WV Video Lottery program to the CFCRG program. In FY2003, a Fast Track Emergency program was created to address the increase of smaller emergency requests and accessibility projects that required a quicker turn around in funds. The most significant change to the program in the last fourteen years was the reduction of available funds to grant and the increase in applications to the program. Effective July 1, 2004, ½ of 1% of video lottery proceeds were capped at \$1.5 million which was then split evenly between the WVDCH and the CFCRG program, leaving available funds for competitive facilities grants at \$750,000.
