

State Historic Preservation Office Our Legacy, Our Future Preservation Awards

Call for Entries

The West Virginia State Historic Preservation Office values the historic preservation efforts of individuals and organizations throughout West Virginia. This awards program honors the exemplary work of dedicated people who keep our state moving forward as they help to preserve and protect our historic resources. It recognizes the preservationists and preservation projects that insure our historic resources remain a vital part of our communities.

Recommendations for nominees for these awards will be accepted until **September 15, 2017**. Awards will be presented at an awards reception at West Virginia Independence Hall in Wheeling on Sunday, October 15, 2017 at 2 pm.

Award Categories

Betty Woods "Snookie" Nutting Award

Ms. Nutting has a passion for historic preservation that is inspiring and contagious. Her lifelong pursuit of historic preservation projects in her hometown of Wheeling, West Virginia, are an outstanding example of how one person, working one building at a time, can have an impact on a community. She has made a recognizable difference in Wheeling and throughout the state through volunteer work with the local historic landmark commission and historic preservation nonprofit organizations. This award will be presented to a West Virginian who embodies the spirit and dedication that is making a difference in a community.

Individual Historic Resource Awards

This category includes historic preservation efforts associated with an individual history resource that is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.

- **Individual Person**: This award recognizes a person who demonstrates dedication to the historic preservation associated with an individual resource and whose work has helped to preserve the story of the resource.
- **Individual Resource**: This award recognizes an individual resource that represents a significant aspect of West Virginia's history and plays a role in the understanding of that history.

Historic District Awards

This category includes historic preservation efforts associated with historic resources such as historic districts, rural landscapes and battlefields.

- **Organization**: This award recognizes an organization that has made a significant contribution to the preservation of an historic district through restoration, research and attention to the importance of the district.
- **Historic District**: This award recognizes an historic district that is comprised of multiple components that reflects a significant aspect of West Virginia's history and is an example of what preservation can mean to a community.
