### FESTIVAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Walk, rather than drive, between campsites.
- RV generators may not be used in the upper lot next to the stage.
- Generators may be used in the lower lot only.
- No fires are allowed.
- Wash dishes in designated areas only.
- Festival is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Observe safety rules: No bicycles, skateboards, roller blades, ATVs, etc. on the mountaintop.
- Dogs may not run free. All dogs must be on a 6’ maximum leash at all times. Extendable leashes are not acceptable.
- Alcoholic beverages and weapons are prohibited.
- State facilities are tobacco-free zones.
